



## **ARNISSA MEMBERSHIP**

Article II of the ARNISSA By-Laws (as amended August 2003) provides for two classes of membership – Regular and Non-Voting.

1. Regular membership is available to:
  - (a) All retired civilian Special Agents of the Naval Criminal Investigative Service or its predecessor organizations (hereafter “the organization”).
  - (b) Former civilian Special Agents of the organization honorably separated for reasons other than retirement, after having so served for a minimum of two years.
  - (c) Former military personnel who served as Director or Deputy of the organization, or who carried organization credentials and performed Special Agent investigative duties for a minimum of two years.
  - (d) Civilian personnel who performed non-investigative duties in the organization for a minimum of two years.
  - (e) Former civilian employees of two or more years who worked in a non-investigative status with the organization and later became a Special Agent with another federal agency.
2. Non-voting membership is available to:
  - (a) Those currently serving as Special Agents of the Naval Criminal Investigative Service who have served a minimum of two years.
  - (b) The surviving spouse of any Regular or Non-Voting member – free of dues.
