The Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS) has a long history of service to the Nation and Department of the Navy. Originally chartered in 1882 as the Office of Naval Intelligence (ONI), later the Naval Investigative Service (NIS) and since 1992, the NCIS has served as the Department of the Navy's primary law enforcement and counterintelligence arm. Today's NCIS is comprised of a corps of federal law enforcement special agents, analysts, and professional support personnel. The NCIS mission includes major criminal investigations as well as our Nation's fight against international terrorism.

The NCISA was originally established as the Association of Retired NIS Special Agents dedicated to bringing together those who had served with ONI and NIS. Today's NCISA includes those individuals as well as active duty, retired and former members of the NCIS and carries out the Association's mission of maintaining a fraternal, social and professional relationship of our members. NCISA sponsors a scholarship program for relatives of our members and also provides monetary support to select interns serving in the NCIS Intern Program. Through these and other means, the NCISA also serves as a link to the active NCIS.
